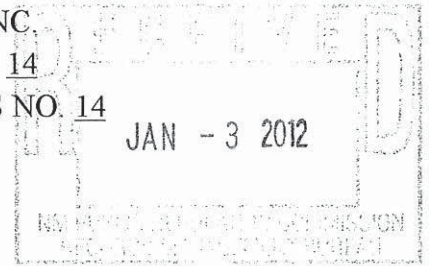

SHORTAGE OF SUPPLY

- A. The Cooperative will use reasonable diligence in furnishing a regular and uninterrupted supply of energy, but the Cooperative shall not be liable for damages in case such supply should be interrupted or fail by reason of fire, earthquake, flood, or other casualty or accident; strikes or labor disputes; war, civil strife or other violence; and law, order, proclamation, regulation, ordinance, action, demand or requirement of any government agency or utility; or any other act or condition beyond the reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of the Cooperative. The Cooperative shall not be liable for damages occasioned by interruption of, or reduction in, service when such interruptions or reductions are necessary to make emergency repairs or changes in the Cooperative's generation, transmission or distribution facilities. - B. The Cooperative reserves the right to limit new or additional power service commensurate with the available unreserved capacity in production, transmission, distribution and substation facilities. In all cases where such existing facilities are limited, the Cooperative may require a written contract for a suitable initial contract period, adequate to warrant the investment and reservation of capacity required to render such power service. X
