COTTON GIN SERVICE

**APPLICABILITY:**

To all cotton gins where capacity is available.

**TERRITORY:**

System wide.

**RATE:**

DEMAND CHARGE

\$ 2.50 per month per kilowatt of billing demand

The billing demand is the greater of the measured kilowatt demand in the billing period, the connected load, or the Service Agreement contract demand.

ENERGY CHARGE

First 200 kWh per billing kW per month @ \$0.064330 per kWh

Next 200 kWh per billing kW per month @ \$0.047577 per kWh

All additional kWh per billing kW per month @ \$0.035013 per kWh

SERVICE AVAILABILITY CHARGE


\$75.00 – No kWh allowed per month

**TAX ADJUSTMENT:**

Billings under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, State and Federal income taxes) payable by the utility and levied or assessed by any Governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of service.

**STANDBY/BACK-UP SERVICE RIDER:** X

The Standby/Back-Up Service Rider shall apply to: X

- A. All cotton gin service users that can self-generate fifty (50) kW or greater, or in other ways provide, a portion of their own requirements, but are capable of receiving a portion of their requirements from the Cooperative X

All existing cotton gin service users after the effective date of this Rider that install additional self-generation of fifty (50) kW or greater, modify existing self-generation facilities of fifty (50) kW or greater, or in other ways provide a portion of their own requirements but continue to receive a portion of their requirements from the Cooperative. Cotton Gin Service users subject to the Standby/Back-Up Service Rider shall pay the Cooperative's applicable tariff charges and all additional charges billed by Western Farmers Electric Cooperative (WFEC) to the Cooperative pursuant to WFEC's Standby/Back-Up Service Rider filed at the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission. A copy of the WFEC tariff can be obtained from CVEC upon request. X


**CONTRACT:**

Consumers receiving service under this rate shall be required to execute the Cooperative's Service Agreement for any new service extension pursuant to the Cooperative's Extension Policy, Rule and Regulation No. 15.

**FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:**

The charge per kWh of the above rate shall be increased or decreased by the amount that the Cooperative's purchased power cost per kWh exceeds or is less than \$0.054657 per kWh, as specified by NMPRC Rule 550 and any New Mexico Public Regulation Commission approved variance from the Rule.

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
