On Saturday, March 16, Central Valley Electric Cooperative held a Drive-Thru Annual Meeting at the Bulldog Bowl parking lot.

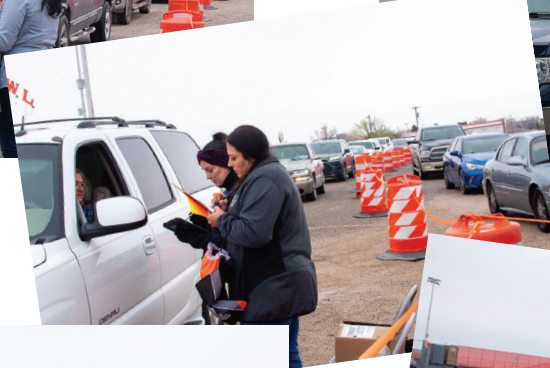
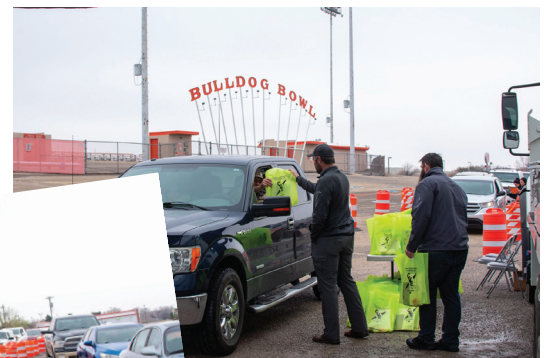
