CENTRAL VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. ORIGINAL RATE No. 19 PHOTOVOLTAIC WATER PUMPING RATE

APPLICABILITY:

For Photovoltaic Water Pumping Systems used for livestock wells and other small water needs. Location of the system must be at least one-half mile from existing single or three phase power lines.

TERRITORY:

System wide.

RATE:

1.2% of installed system cost/month with a contract period of ten years.

MEMBER REQUIREMENTS:

The member must provide a well that is capable

of providing the water requirements they are requesting.

The member must provide the site for installation of the Photovoltaic System (PV System) as well as the necessary fixture on which to mount the PV System. Fencing will also be required to protect the PV system from livestock.

The member must provide the DC/AC voltage water pump and all necessary water well related material.

The member must obtain prior approval from the cooperative before purchasing the pump system to assure that all components will work properly together.

COOPERATIVE REQUIREMENTS:

The cooperative will provide installation of the PV system including all items necessary to generate the DC/AC voltage and will provide a switch box for disconnecting and point of delivery of power. The cooperative will remove the PV system at the end of the contract period.

CONTRACT PERIOD:

The initial contract period is ten years. Following this initial contract period the contract will be extended on a month to month basis until one month prior notification is received by the cooperative.

MAINTENANCE:

The Cooperative will be responsible for maintaining all above ground equipment such as photovoltaic panels and switch box. The member will be responsible for maintaining all down hole components of the system including the pump, the motor, wire, etc. from the switch box to the well.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this rate may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, State and Federal income taxes) payable by the utility and levied or assessed by any Governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of service.
