DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Application – All Customers 'X' – Majority of Rules and Regulations has changed

- A. The cooperative will furnish service to all consumers in its service area where facilities are available, or may feasibly be made available, for the type of load to be served and at the required voltage.
- B. The Cooperative will use reasonable diligence in furnishing a regular and uninterrupted supply of energy, but the Cooperative shall not be liable for damages in case such supply should be interrupted or fail by reason of fire, earthquake, flood, or other casualty or accident; strikes or labor disputes; war, civil strife or other violence; and law, order, proclamation, regulation, ordinance, action, demand or requirement of any government agency or utility; or any other act or condition beyond the reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of the Cooperative. The Cooperative shall not be liable for damages occasioned by interruption of, or reduction in, service when such interruptions or reductions are necessary to make emergency repairs or changes in the Cooperative's generation, transmission or distribution facilities.
- C. Electric service furnished shall be the character known as 60 cycle, alternating current. Voltage and phase of the service supplied shall be determined by the service available and requested by the consumer.
