



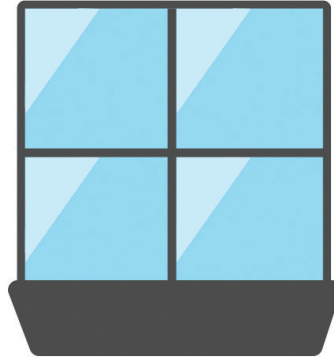

A home energy audit is an inspection and evaluation of a home's energy efficiency level. CVE works with Green Medal Energy to offer this no cost weatherization energy efficiency program that includes duct sealing, air sealing, caulking, weather-stripping and a 10-pack of LED light bulbs.

Other Energy Efficiency Programs & Rebates

MARATHON WATER HEATERS:

CVE sells Marathon Water Heater to members at 60 percent off the co-ops price. We carry a variety of sizes and these water heaters come with a lifetime warranty on the tank and five year warranty on the parts (as long as you register the water heater within 90 days of purchase). *Water heater must be installed in a home or business receiving electricity from CVE.*



COMMERCIAL LIGHTING REBATE:

CVE offers rebates to Commercial & Industrial members who want to upgrade their inefficient lighting, or who are constructing a new building. *Outdoor lighting, including parking lot lights, outdoor wall packs, etc. do not qualify.*



HEATING & COOLING REBATES:




Heating and cooling is typically the number one energy consumer in homes and buildings. CVE promotes the installation of energy efficient heating and cooling equipment when constructing new buildings or remodeling existing ones. We have rebates

for both Air Source Heat Pumps and Ground Source Heat Pumps. *Specific equipment requirements do apply.*

VARIABLE FREQUENCY DRIVES:

CVE wants to promote energy efficient methods for motor and pump based systems using Variable Frequency Drives (VFD). Rebates are available for the installation of VFDs to control end-use pump and motor equipment/systems. *Specific guidelines do apply.*
