Solar Screen ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM

I. OBJECTIVE

Solar screens are a proven low-cost method for reducing cooling bills. They allow daylight to enter a building while blocking heat. Central Valley Electric Cooperative promotes the installation of energy-efficient solar screens.

II. POLICY CONTENT

CVE's solar screen rebate provides residential members with a rebate on solar screens.

III. PROVISIONS

A. Program Qualifications and Restrictions

- 1. The installation of solar screens must be installed in a permanent residence that CVE serves.
- To qualify for a solar screen rebate, the home must be cooled by refrigerated air conditioning or heated with electric resistance heat or a heat pump.
- 3. Solar screens must be installed on west and south-facing windows.
- 4. Solar screens must be installed on single-pane windows, which cannot be shaded by existing awnings, exterior curtains, or any other shading device.
- 5. Solar screen must be rated to block at a minimum of eighty percent (80%) of solar heat
- 6. New construction and additions to existing homes do not qualify for solar screen rebates.
- 7. Solar screens installed on east-facing windows do not qualify.

B. Rebate Information

1. CVE will provide a rebate of \$1.00 per square foot for the treated west and south-facing window space. Rebate must not exceed forty percent (40%) of the purchase cost. (taxes and labor not included)

IV. RULES AND GUIDELINES

To receive rebate funds, a completed Rebate Application with appropriate signatures and additional required documents must be submitted.

- Must include a copy of a dated receipt for solar screen costs or a paid-in-full contactor invoice.
- You must provide pre- and post-pictures where solar screens are installed.
- Solar screens must be brand new.
- Solar screens must be fully installed before a rebate can be issued.
- Members must apply for rebates within 90 days of installing the solar screens.
 Rebates will be issued within 30 days of the approved application.

- Rebates will be given in the form of a check or utility bill credit.
- CVE does not guarantee a specific level of energy or cost savings will result from implementing or using products funded under this program.
- CVE is not liable for any damages caused by the operation or malfunction of the installed equipment.
- CVE reserves the right to inspect and verify that solar screens were installed.
- Rebates will be capped at \$75,000.00 annually for any one member. This amount applies to the combined total of all other CVE rebate programs.
- To receive the rebate, CVE members must be current (within 60 days) in the payment of their account(s).

V. PROGRAM FUNDING

Funding for this program will be from the Renewable Energy and Energy Conservation Fund. Should the Renewable Energy and Energy Conservation Fund become deficient in funds; the Solar Screen Rebate Program will become inactive until such time funds are available.
