- And much more














## **Used Power Poles**

Central Valley Electric Cooperative has an abundance of used no-value power poles we need to clear out. Poles are FREE to anyone who can use them. Here are just a few ways you can use a used power pole:

- Fencing material
- Garden borders
- Retaining walls
- Furniture
- Back yard pergolas
- Seasonal decorations
- And much more



We have poles cut into lengths of 10, 15 and 20 feet, and also some full length 50 foot poles. Bring a truck and trailer and our friendly warehouse staff will load them for you. Poles are treated with preservatives and can not be used for firewood or construction of any dwelling.
