Safe Haven is one way we can work together to help keep our communities a safe place to live, work and play.

- **Where can people go for help?**

Go to any vehicle with the familiar CVE or PVT logo and the Safe Haven bumper sticker.

- **How does the program work?**

When you approach our vehicle, our employees will request your name, determine the problem, and request assistance from the police or other appropriate authorities as needed – and they will stay with you until help arrives.

The Merchant Program is one of the most comprehensive training programs for power line personnel. It is a four-year curriculum for entry-level utility personnel, and combines technical instruction and on-the-job training.
